Michael Feisel sat his wife's bed on fire while she and their three children were sleeping. He then went down and sat down stairs to drink beer and wait for their screams, reports CSB4 Boston.

Amy Feisel told the police that she woke up to flames and her husband standing at the foot of her bed. She ended up saving herself and their children.

Her husband was sent to Carbon County Prison and charged with four counts of attempted homicide.

Two Stratford women were arrested accused of scamming a woman out of \$145,000 through weird rituals including drinking rooster blood, reports the Washington Post.

Maria dos Santos and her daughter Shirley Iannucci had become friendly with the alleged victim that happened to be going through a divorce last year. Santos talked the victim into letting her handle all her financial affairs while the victim's divorce was pending.

According to court records, after Santos told the alleged victim that "God was going to kill her", she feared for her life. The woman called the police after Santos performed a satanic ritual at her home that included drinking blood from a dead rooster.

A man in Glen Cove, New York was arrested on charges that he dismembered his neighbor and drove around with her severed head in the trunk of his car according to the Associated Press.

Police said that Evan Marshall kept the victim's body parts inside several trash bins in the basement of his home, except the head which he drove around with in his 1990 Toyota.

A cruise ship pulled into its Alaskan port with a 25 to 30 foot dead hump back whale pinned to its bow, reports the Associated Press.

The crew of the passenger ship said that they were surprised to learn that they had hit a whale. A spokesman for Celebrity Cruises said that they had

felt no bump during their journey.

Scott Adams, an enforcement officer with the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, said that they have no knowledge as to if the whale struck the cruise ship or another vessel or if it just died of some genetic issue.

Federal officials said a boat crew that reports the incident and that is not pursuing or harassing whales are not likely to get into trouble.

Godparents of a three year old boy named Christopher Thomas staged boxing matches with his brother as a "spectator sport", before he died of brain injuries, according to Sacbee: Breaking News.

The godparents thought of the boxing match and other acts of violence as an "amusement". It all ended when the boy died on July 19 2004. Thomas died bleeding to the brain, said Deputy District Attorney Shakely.

In court they showed a tape of Earl Joseph Christopher, godparent, encouraging the boys to fight each other. Christopher told the brothers that they were not hitting each other hard enough. Thomas hit his brother on the side of the head, causing him to fall down. The godparent Earl Joseph Christopher responded with, "Christopher is the winner. Now do your victory dance."

A man stabbed three girls for laughing. The girls were on a bus and the man told them to shut up. When the girls got off the bus the man went after them and attacked them with a knife, reports Mirror.co.uk.

Charlotte Teague, 14, had a long blade stuck into her chest and stomach. Sophie Hyne, 15, and cousin Kirsty Edwards, 17, were stabbed many times by the madman.

Hyne was stabbed three times in the face and back while Edwards was stabbed two times in the back and stomach.

People passing by on the street would stop and help the girls any way they could.

The police sealed off the town and searched for the knifeman. They found him later and arrested him.
